<p>Sing and do the actions for the Jolly Phonics songs https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=hlQ5L9xgU4g&t=250s</p> <p>Complete a sound activity from your reader. Choose a letter and find it in a story book.</p>	<p>Ask your child to make a simple pattern with two things (ex. fork, spoon, fork, spoon. Or red, yellow, red, yellow)</p>	<p>Watch "Pete the Cat- I Love my White Shoes" on Youtube. https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=fj_z6zGQVvM</p> <p>Ask your child to find something of each colour in your house.</p>
<p>Ask your child to name a word that rhymes with: cat, hop, pan, rug, net, and pig.</p>	<p>Help your child count 20 objects by touching just one item at a time. You could count buttons, coins, etc.</p>	<p>Go on a nature scavenger hunt in your back yard. Can you find: a twig, a leaf, a flower, and an insect? Can you make this into an artwork.</p>
<p>Syllable Clapping - Ask your child to clap and count how many syllables are in these words: hippo, alligator, bird, elephant, puppy, cat, rhinoceros, flamingo, zebra, cow and then choose your own words.</p>	<p>Shape Hunt. Ask your child to find examples of these shapes around the house or yard: circle, square, triangle, rectangle, oval, and diamond.</p>	<p>At different points in the day, stop and talk about what emotion your child is currently feeling.</p>
<p>Read a book with your child. Ask them questions: Who are the characters? What happened in the story? What do you think will happen next?</p>	<p>Have your child draw a picture with: 1 sun, 3 trees, and 5 flowers. Ask them how many things they drew all together and help them count them - (9)</p>	<p>Help your child practice learning their address and the emergency phone number (000). Talk about what to do in an emergency.</p>
<p>Have your child practice writing their name. Write a random letter on paper. See if your child can name the letter and the sound it makes. Do this for 10 letters.</p>	<p>Search around the house for something: longer than a pencil, shorter than your shoe, heavier than a book, and lighter than a pillow.</p>	<p>Play "I Spy" with your child. Give them clues and see if they can figure out what you see.</p> <p>Play a board or card game with your child.</p>
