



- SCHOOL STARTS AT 9.00AM -WHY IT'S IMPORTANT TO BE AT SCHOOL ON TIME

Students arriving to school with time to spare have the luxury of settling in, greeting their teachers and classmates, code switching from home to school to focus their minds on the lessons to come.

Students arriving late miss out on this natural transition period (morning circle), and chronic lateness may cause students to struggle with academic focus, relationships with peers and emotional management.

Showing up on time to school every day can help students develop the habit of being punctual, illustrates to them your commitment to their learning and friendships, and helps reduce classroom interruptions and distractions for all students.

Missing just 15 minutes of school, twice a week, equates to 3 missed school days per year!

As we consider the possibilities for 2024, a new year and a fresh start, we ask <u>all Melrose families</u> to make a renewed commitment to arriving to school on time. This helps your child's teacher, their classmates AND your child.
