## - SCHOOL STARTS AT 9.00AM -WHY IT'S IMPORTANT TO BE AT SCHOOL ON TIME

Students arriving to school with time to spare have the luxury of settling in, greeting their teachers and classmates, code switching from home to school to focus their minds on the lessons to come.

Students arriving late miss out on this natural transition period (morning circle), and chronic lateness may cause students to struggle with academic focus, relationships with peers and emotional management.

Showing up on time to school every day can help students develop the habit of being punctual, illustrates to them your commitment to their learning and friendships, and helps reduce classroom interruptions and distractions for all students.

Missing just 15 minutes of school, twice a week, equates to 3 missed school days per year!

As we consider the possibilities for 2024, a new year and a fresh start, we ask <u>all Melrose families</u> to make a renewed commitment to arriving to school on time. #### RIDING, SCOOTING AND WALKING ARE ENCOURAGED MODES OF GETTING TO SCHOOL

#### When students are riding a bike or scooter to school they are required to:

- . Wear a helmet at all times whilst on their bike or scooter
- . Walk the bike or scooter within the school grounds.
- . Hop off their bike/scooter at the school gates and walk it to and from the bike shed.
- . Please bring their own bike lock to secure the item whilst it is in the bike shed

The bike shed is available for students to store their bike during the day. The shed is closed but not locked.

It is the students responsibility to lock up their own bike/scooter (with a bike lock) to secure the item throughout the day.
