



#### CSEF - CAMPS, SPORTING, EXCURSION FUND APPLICATIONS 2024 -

The Camps, Sports and Excursion Fund (CSEF) helps eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities. If you have a valid means-tested concession card, such as a Veterans Affairs Gold Card, Centrelink Health Care Card or Pensioner Concession Card, or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible. There is also a special consideration category for asylum seeker and refugee families.

#### Payment amounts this year are \$150 for eligible primary school students.

Payments are made direct to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions and sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

If you applied with Melrose for CSEF last year, you do not need to complete an application form

- this year unless:

   You are a new family to Melrose, and have not applied for CSEF with Melrose before
- You have applied last year but have a 2024 Foundation student starting with us this year OR
- There has been a change in your family circumstances, which now makes you eligible for

CSEF If you would like to apply for the first time, please contact the school office on 0260591955 and ask for an application form.

You can also download the form from our school website, and there is also a form attached to this weeks newsletter. To find out more about the program and eligibility, go to the Department of Education and Training's Camps. Sports and Excursions Fund web page.
