#### YEAR 3/4 - FLYAWAY GYMNASTICS

#### Smile Squad dental packs

All children deserve a healthy smile, and the Smile Squad free school dental program is working hard to help wake sure this happens. Your children) will scon receive a free dental pack to bring home. The dental pack contains a toothbrush, full sized toothpaste, and an oral health brochure. Please take the time to read the brochure. It's full of helpful hints and tips to help your whole family eat well, drink well and clean well - for life. Smile Squad provides standards strength fluoride toothpaste that is generally used by ages six and over, unless recommended by a dental or trained health professional.

If your child is under six, please talk to a dental or trained health professional to find out if your child might benefit from using this toothpaste. You can also choose to put the toothpaste away until they turn six or give it to someone else in your family to use.

Smile Squad is a Victorian Government program that provides free dental care to all Victorian government primary and secondary school students. We will let you know when Smile Squad will be coming to our school to provide dental examinations. Although Smile Squad is not visiting our school just yet, you can access free dental for students by calling your local comunity dental clinic Albury Wodonga Health and asking for a Smile Squad appointment. #### Steps to enrol your child in Foundation (Prep) for the 2025 school year

To start primary school in 2025, your child will need to turn 5 years old by 30 April 2025. Schooling is compulsory for children who have turned 6 years old. If your child is starting Foundation (Prep) in 2025, you will be able to apply to enrol your child in a Victorian Government primary school from the start of Ferm 2, 2024 (Monday 15 April 2024).

#### What you need to do:

 Use Find my School <u>https://www.findmyschool.vic.gov.au</u> to locate your designated neighbourhood school (referred to as your local school) and other nearby government schools.

Contact a government primary school to book a school tour or to learn more about the school and the enrolment application process.
Download the Foundation (Prep) Enrolment Information Pack for Parents and Carers (PDF, 15 MB) This pack includes an application

form. The school may also provide you with a copy of the form to complete.

#### 4. Submit an enrolment application for Foundation (Prep) by Friday 26 July 2024.

5. You will be notified of the outcome of your application between Monday 29 July and Friday 9 August 2024. If you receive an enrolment

- offer, you should accept the offer by Friday 23 August 2024.
- 6. Take part in information and transition sessions during Term 4, 2024.
- 7. Your child will start Foundation (Prep) from Wednesday 29 January 2025.

# Enrolment applications submitted after 26 July 2024 will be processed by the school as they are received, in accordance with the Department of Education's Placement Policy.

Your child has a right to enrol at their local school. Your child's local school is determined on the basis of their permanent residential address. Visit <u>Find my School</u> to locate your child's local school. The <u>enrolling in a school</u> page can also help you to confirm your child's address for enrolment. If you are seeking to apply to enrol your child in a school that is not their local school, you should read about <u>school</u> and how they work. You should also read about how applications are prioritised using the Department of Education's Placement Policy found on the <u>enrolling in a school page</u>.
