# 2025 - \$400 SCHOOL SAVING BONUS

# TO RECEIVE THE BONUS, THE SCHOOL MUST HAVE : YOUR CURRENT EMAIL ADDRESS AND CONTACT DETAILS

# Who receives the School Saving Bonus

The School Saving Bonus is available for parents and carers of all Victorian government school students from Prep to Year 12 in 2025, except for full-fee international students, home schooled students, TAFE students and students attending kindergarten in 2025.

### Actions for parents and carers

Parents and carers of children who meet the School Saving Bonus eligibility above are required to do the following by Friday 18 October 2024:

- Complete enrolment Only if your child, or children are changing government school for Term 1 2025, or starting Prep or Year 7 in 2025, please
  complete enrolment. If your child is already enrolled and attending at Melrose for 2024, then you do not need to re-enrol.
- Check your contact information Ensure your contact information is up to date with your school. You can check this information by checking your email address and phone numbers on the school portal app to see if they are correct, or if you are unable to do this you can contact the school office directly.

# Accessing the \$400 School Saving Bonus

You do not need to apply for the School Saving Bonus. The Department of Education will email you in November 2024 with your \$400 School Saving Bonus. You will be able to access it via an online system. You can decide how to best use the School Saving Bonus for your family's needs. You can choose how to allocate the \$4400 in the online system. The bonus can be used towards 2025 school costs, which may include:

· camps, trips, excursions and incursions, swimming and sporting programs, outdoor education programs, graduations, school uniforms, textbooks.

Session 1: Tuesday 19th November 2024 - 915am - 10.15am Stuents will participate in play-based activities and a music session with staff A PARENT INFORMATION SESSION WILL ALSO BE HELD ON THIS DAY, WITH OUR PRINCIPAL BEN SLOCOMES, STRAIGHT AFTER STUDENT DROP OFF, IN THE MULTI PURPOSE ROOM.

Session 2: Tuesday 26th November 2024 - 9:15am - 10:15am Students will participate in an art and craft activity in the Foundation Classrooms.

#### Session 3: Tuesday 3rd December 2024 - 9:15am - 10:15am

Students will read a story about starting school and complete an activity about what they will need to bring to school each day.

#### Session 4: Tuesday 10th December 2024 - 9:15am - 11:15am

This is the State Wide Transition Day Students will participate in a range of activities that are aimed to introduce them to the year ahead. Students will also complete an art and craft activity. On this day, students will be in their 2025 classes. Please pack a fruit snack and a water bottle.

On the final transition day, students will receive their special transition bags full of 'Ready for School' goodles, such as a drink bottle, learning resources, educational activities, etc....... They will also receive a school hat and reading satchel on their first day at school for 2025

# Steps to enrol your child in Foundation (Prep) for the 2025 school year

To start primary school in 2025, your child will need to turn 5 years old by 30 April 2025. Schooling is compulsory for children who have turned 6 years old. If your child is starting Foundation (Prep) in 2025, you will be able to apply to enrol your child in a Victorian Government primary school from the start of Ferm 2, 2024 (Monday 15 April 2024).

#### What you need to do:

 Use Find my School <u>https://www.findmyschool.vic.gov.au</u> to locate your designated neighbourhood school (referred to as your local school) and other nearby government schools.

Contact a government primary school to book a school tour or to learn more about the school and the enrolment application process.
 Download the Foundation (Prep) Enrolment Information Pack for Parents and Carers (PDF, 15 MB) This pack includes an application

form. The school may also provide you with a copy of the form to complete.

## 4. Submit an enrolment application for Foundation (Prep) by Friday 26 July 2024.

5. You will be notified of the outcome of your application between Monday 29 July and Friday 9 August 2024. If you receive an enrolment

- offer, you should accept the offer by Friday 23 August 2024.
- 6. Take part in information and transition sessions during Term 4, 2024.
- 7. Your child will start Foundation (Prep) from Wednesday 29 January 2025.

# Enrolment applications submitted after 26 July 2024 will be processed by the school as they are received, in accordance with the Department of Education's Placement Policy.

Your child has a right to enrol at their local school. Your child's local school is determined on the basis of their permanent residential address. Visit <u>Find my School</u> to locate your child's local school. The <u>enrolling in a school</u> page can also help you to confirm your child's address for enrolment. If you are seeking to apply to enrol your child in a school that is not their local school, you should read about <u>school</u> and how they work. You should also read about how applications are prioritised using the Department of Education's Placement Policy found on the <u>enrolling in a school page</u>.
