YEAR 6 TO YEAR 7 STUDENTS HEADSTART TRANSITION WEEK

Monday 9th - Friday 13th DECEMBER, 2024 9.00am - 3.10pm everyday

Our current 2024 Year 6 students, transferring to Wodonga Middle Years Huon or Felltimber Campuses in 2025, will participate in their HEADSTART transition program for the whole week.

Students will go straight to their appropriate campus on each of the transition days, and will not need to come to Melrose on these dates. Students are required to wear their full Melrose school uniform to this transition week.

This transition week does not apply to students attending Catholic College or Tallangatta Secondary in 2025. CURRENT 2024 FOUNDATION TO YEAR 5 STUDENTS ON-SITE TRANSITION DAY TUESDAY 10th DECEMBER, 2024

Our current 2024 Foundation to Year 5 students will transition to their 2025 classroom, with their 2025 teacher and peers for their transition session between 9.15am-11.15am, on Tuesday 10th December, 2024. The rest of the day will be a normal school day.

In 2025, Year 6 Students will then be able to war these polo shirts to school, as part of the sports and school uniform in 2025. This uniform tem is not compulsory, and will not be available for purchase through school uniform shops. You will only be able to purchase this item through this process. The design will be similar to the previous year's polos, with an Indigenous pattern as part of the design. (Final design will be communicated once this has been established).
