SCHOOL HATS - COMPULSORY

As per our School Uniform Policy, ALL students MUST wear a plain, navy, broad brimmed hat for all outside activities during all of Term 1 and Term 4.

These are available from the school office for \$14 each.
Peaked caps are not acceptable, as they do not meet our sun smart policy requirements.

CSEF – CAMPS, SPORTING, EXCURSION FUND APPLICATIONS 2025 –

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSFF. A special consideration category also exists for asylum seeker and refugee families. The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

The annual CSEF amount per student is:

- \$154 for primary school students
- \$256 for secondary school students
- If you applied with Melrose for CSEF last year, you do not need to complete an application form this year unless:
- You are a new family to Melrose, and have not applied for CSEF with Melrose before
- You have applied last year but have a 2025 Foundation student starting with us this year OR
- There has been a change in your family circumstances, which now makes you eligible for CSEF

If you would like to apply at Melrose for the first time, please contact the school office on 206099 1955 and ask for an application form. You can also download the form from our school website, and there is also a form attached to this weeks newsletter.
