CSEF - CAMPS, SPORTING, EXCURSION FUND APPLICATIONS 2025 -School camps provide children with inspiring experiences in the great outdoors. Excursions encourage a deeper understanding of how the world works while sports teach teamwork, discipline and leadership. All are a part of a healthy curriculum. CSEF is provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities. If you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible

If you applied with Melrose for CSEF last year, you do not need to complete an application form this year unless:
