Please log onto the School Portal App to approve permission for your child to attend this excursion. Cost: \$12.00 (if you are eligible for CSEF it will cover the cost of this excursion.)

CSEF – CAMPS, SPORTING, EXCURSION FUND APPLICATIONS 2025 –

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSEF. A special consideration category also exists for asylum seeker and refugee families. The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

The annual CSEF amount per student is:

- \$154 for primary school students
- \$256 for secondary school students

If you applied with Melrose for CSEF last year, you do not need to complete an application form this year unless:

- You are a new family to Melrose, and have not applied for CSEF with Melrose before
- You have applied last year but have a 2025 Foundation student starting with us this year OR
- There has been a change in your family circumstances, which now makes you eligible for CSEF

If you would like to apply at Melrose for the first time, please contact the school office on 2065991955 and ask for an application form. You can also download the form from our school website, and there is also a form attached to this weeks newsletter. To find out more about the program and eligibility, go to the Department of Education and Training's Camps. Sports and Excursions Fund web page. Check with the school office if you are unsure, and please return compileted forms to the school office.
